Note that the above dates reflect TUESDAY starting dates.

These schools cover the current production equipment only. The engine drive schools will be held as generic schools. The student will need to supply the Ground Power Service Department with a complete list of serial numbers of the units owned. This way, the unique information to their units can be covered.

The D.C. schools will cover the DC Engine Driven Equipment (either JET-EX5D or JET-EX6D based on customers) and the GPU-400 (or GPU-600).

Be sure that the necessary information is received at Hobart Ground Power at least 1 month prior to the beginning school date. The schools have limited space and are on a first come first served basis.

Note: Personal Protective Equipment (“PPE”) Policy

All Hobart Ground Power employees, contractors, vendors, and visitors are subject to the requirements of this policy and must wear appropriate personal protective equipment as identified by hazard assessments conducted by the Business Unit. PPE required in the GP Production Area includes: ANSI approved safety glasses. While steel-toed shoes are not a requirement for visitors, they are required to wear full cover shoes (no open toes).

Hobart Ground Power 2012 Factory Training

The training schools are conducted at the factory in Troy, Ohio

The tuition for the schools in 2012 is \$600 per student per school. Purchasers of new equipment may contact the selling Agency for discounted training.

The students are responsible for their travel to and from Troy, Ohio, transportation while in Troy, meals, and lodging.

The training courses begin on **Tuesday** at approximately 8:30 a.m. and will end at approximately 4:30 p.m. each day. The length of the training is approximately 2 to 3 days depending on the model covered.

It will be necessary to have the school request confirmed in writing at least one month prior to the course beginning date. Use the enclosed form for the confirmation.
